Dear Mildred:

Hope this letter find you in good health, Peg and I are doing fine, We just got back from New Orleans, took our new motor home on its first trip. Still working on the Curry book, found out some more information, on Matilda, your grandmother, she died on April 27, 1931 at age 70 and 7 months. She is buried in St. Raymond's Cemetery Bronx NY. We are going to make a trip to the Cemetery in the next few weeks ,I hope. If we do I will take a picture of the grave and send it to you. Your grandfather Thomas Patrick died on May 25, 1916 at age 59 years, 11 months and 23 days . His parents are listed as thomas Curry of Ireland, and Ellen Reilly also of Ireland. He was living at 788 E.181st Street Bronx NY at the time of his death. He is also buried in St.Raymond's Cemetery.

We found your Father's death certificate, he died on August 13, 1944 at Age 66, and 11 days. The information on the death certificate was given my Louise Lawsan, his daughter, Louise was married twice, first to Henry E. Diehl, and had one child by the name of Matilda Diehl, You probably remember her. He also had two sons, Your Father, and Thomas F. Curry, who married Minnie Koenig, they had three children, Charles ,Thomas,and Mabel. Do you remember any of them ?.

Mildred, I am enclosing a picture of two couples, The picture is not very clear, but will you see if you can identify the couple on the left as you are looking at the picture, I know who the couple on the right are, they are my great grandparents, Charles and Henrietta Curry.

We found the marriage certificate for Thomas F.Curry and Minnie Koenig, it lists his parents as Thomas P.Curry, and Tillie Becker. and her's as Charles H. King,(Koenig nears King in German) Louise Bromhurst. We can't find any information on their children.

Hope you had a nice Easter, and I am looking forward to seeing you again, If you are ever up this way please give me a call. I very much would like to see you.

Just remembered something, Dan Gaugh sent me a picture of your sister Rita Dorothy, she looks very much like my Aunt Mary Curry Barrett when she was younger. I could not get over how much they looked alike.
