*Curry* 5- Louise Henriette Curry-Diehl-Lawsan. born August 20, 1881, died January 1958 *Age 77?*

6- Henry E. Diehl, born 1879, died June 1920, age 41 ?

7- John Lawsan, born 1892, died July 1952. *Age 60?*

Mildred, see if you can find any old pictures of the Curry's maybe a picture of your grandparents if possible, We will make sure that you get them back, they would be a big help.


